



PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY BORING PERMIT APPLICATION

Through the Applicant acting as an agent, the public service provider shall perform all work in public right-of-way/ public easements in accordance with City ordinances, specifications, and standards as they apply to such work. No change shall be made to the plans under this permit without prior written approval from the Mayor.

Companies applying for permits to bore in the public right-of-way are required to submit a detailed description of the entire project (please attach to permit application), and divide the total project into phases, which encompass a maximum of a three (3) city block area per permit. A permit will be required for each phase as the project continues. All boring activity shall take place between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday. No authorized work will be done, except for line pulling only, or emergencies, on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays or City Holidays. The Mayor, Council Member or City Staff member (or designee) must be on site when boring near a main line of the City. (City Ordinance 26-18-07)
